1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Black Inc. awards are made possible through a grant from the Van Wert County Foundation and are designed to encourage youth to continue with their 4-H projects and expand their knowledge base as they work with their project.

2. REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicant must have met the years of project experience for their age category **(years do not have to be consecutive)**
 - a. Sr. 15-18 yrs (3+) Inter. 11-14 yrs (2+) Jr. 8-10 yrs (no previous experience needed)
- B. Application must be completed in full to be eligible for awards.
 - a. Full sentences should be used in essay.
 - b. Bullet list is acceptable for involvement and activities. (ie: 2010 Presented a demonstration on "How to photograph sporting events".
- C. Applicant will participate in an interview on *Thursday, August 10th, 2023*
- D. Applicant will complete a display about their selected project area focusing on a specific topic within their area of their project.

3. EXHIBIT GUIDELINES

- A. Please ensure that your display is neat, organized and a good representation of the Black Inc. program.
- B. Suggestions for displays include but are not limited to scrapbook of pictures, three dimensional displays or display boards (the Tri-fold standing displays).
- C. Display should be unique every year. Pictures are taken of displays every year to ensure that members create new material for each year.
